2023 CRAGGY RANGE TE MUNA MARTINBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC

Sauvignons from Martinborough, on New Zealand's north Island, tend to have fewer green notes than those of the south Island. This green notes than those of the south island. This bottling mingles grape-fruit and melon flavors with a brisk, story finish.

2022 GREYWACKE MARLBOROUGH WILD SAUVIGNON (\$31)

"Greywacke" refers to the type of bedrock in the vineyards that winemaker Kevin Judo farms: "Wild" refers to his use of native yeasts for fermentation. It's a gorgeous white—flinty and smoky, with lots of creamy citrus fruit and a goeste crunded texture.
